

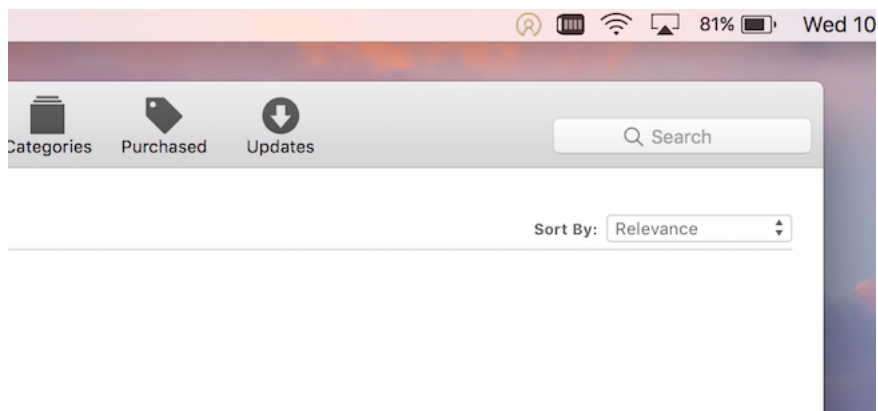
Installing Rubica on OS X \ MacOS.


Installing Rubica on a Mac is as easy as visiting the Mac App Store:

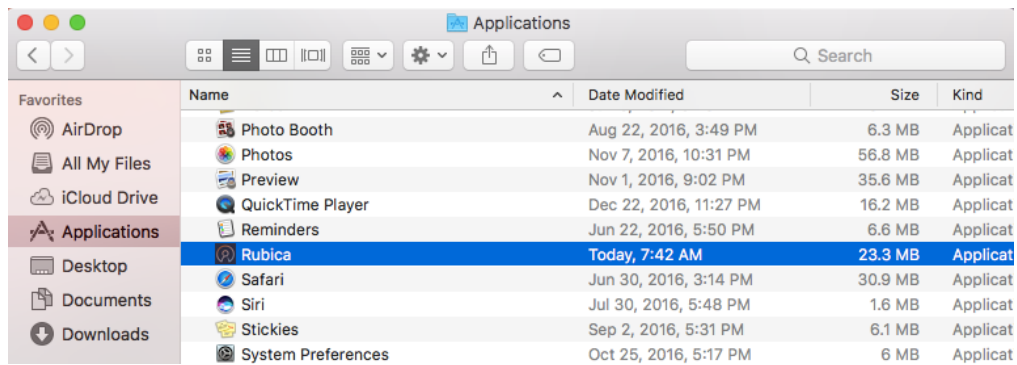
1. Open the Mac App Store from your Applications folder or via Spotlight (Cmd+Space, type 'App Store')
2. From the App Store, search for 'Rubica' and click 'Install':



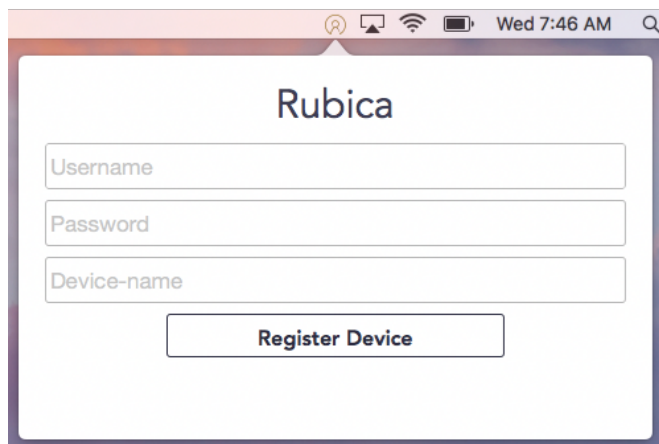
3. When install is complete, click 'Open' and Rubica should start in your menu bar:



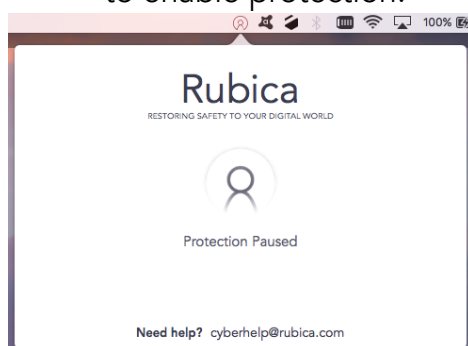
4. If it doesn't appear, in Finder , go to the Applications folder and double-click the Rubica application.

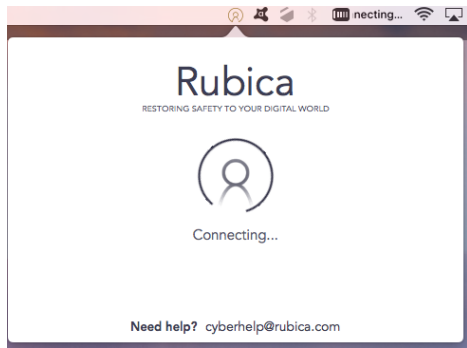


5. This will present the registration popup - enter the Username and Password supplied by Rubica CyberHelp. Enter a device name of your choosing - something you recognize like "John's Mac".

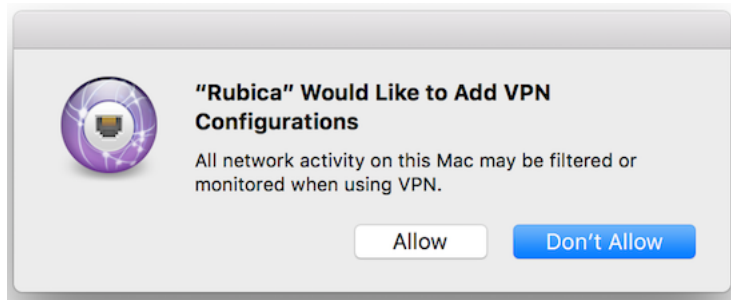


6. When registered, you will see the "Protection Paused" screen. Click on the icon to enable protection.

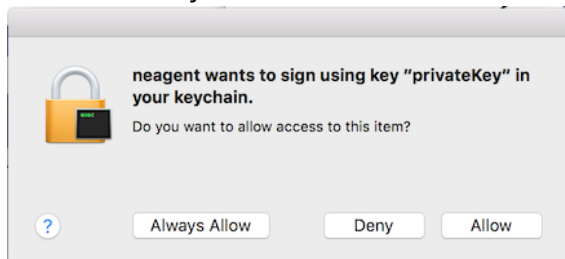




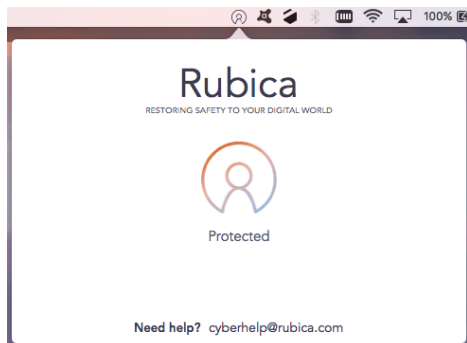
7. When Rubica activates the VPN for the first time, you will see a prompt to allow installation of the Rubica VPN, click 'Allow'.



8. You will then be asked to allow "neagent" access to your keychain. Click "Always Allow".



9. You will see the icon change to "Protected".
